- ✓ Do comment on other research contributions and impacts
[What are other research contributions and impacts?](#)
- ✓ Do consider context of applicant affecting productivity
 - Leave history
 - Career stage
 - Area(s) of research
 - Experiential knowledge
 - Diverse career paths
 - Family responsibilities and pandemic impact

DON'T

- ✗ Don't comment on **h-index** or use journal-based metrics such as **Impact Factor** in isolation.
Speak to the quality and impact of the contribution as described by the applicant.

Use the **NEW** College tools to apply [DORA](#) principles to Applicant's [Productivity](#) and [Context](#) in your [Review](#).
